

Exporting Your Flag Football Stats to MaxPreps

You've always been able to do this — here's the official step-by-step, so every coach and statistician does it the same way.

⚡ A little over 1 minute, start to finish

What you need before you start

- A Blitz Board Stats account with your season's games tracked
- A MaxPreps Coach Admin login for your team
- Your team's MaxPreps schedule already set up with the opponent and date matching the game you tracked

Export from Blitz Board Stats

- 1 Go to **Stats > Season Stats**, select the team/season, and filter to the completed game.
- 2 Click **Export Stats** (or Export All Stats). Under Format, select **MaxPreps**.
- 3 Review athletes and jersey numbers, then click **Export**. Confirm jerseys are set and unique, then click **Download import.txt**.
- 4 Save `import.txt` somewhere you can access it when you log into MaxPreps.

Do this right after the game ends — while the roster and jersey numbers are still fresh, export and upload in one sitting.

Before you upload, check

- ✓ Jersey numbers in Blitz Board Stats match your MaxPreps roster
- ✓ The opponent and date on your MaxPreps schedule match the game you're uploading
- ✓ The file is `import.txt` — that's the one you'll upload

Upload to MaxPreps

- 1 Sign in to MaxPreps with your Coach Admin account.
- 2 Open **Schedule** in the team nav and find the game.
- 3 Open the stat entry page (final score, pencil icon, or **Add Stats** prompt).
- 4 Enter the final score, then choose **Save and Import Stats**.
- 5 In Import Stats, select **Choose .txt File**, pick your `import.txt`, and select **Import**.
- 6 Choose **Calculate Team Totals**, then **Publish and Continue**.

Stats appear on your public MaxPreps team page within 15–30 minutes of publishing.

FAQ

Is this a live sync with MaxPreps?

No. You export a file from Blitz Board Stats and upload it yourself through MaxPreps Coach Admin.

Do I need MaxPreps Pro?

No. A standard Coach Admin account is all you need to import stats.

What levels does this cover?

High school JV and varsity flag football teams using MaxPreps.

Does this work for youth or club teams?

No. MaxPreps covers high school sports specifically, so youth and club games won't have a MaxPreps upload path.
