GAME DAY TIPS

Come prepared

Just like coaches and players, statisticians should come prepared to play. Get set up while the team is warming up.

Set up your device

Charge your device before the event. Stay on strong Wi-Fi or LTE. Only **one statistician** should track per game to avoid duplicate entries.

Roster must be complete first

Confirm all players are on the roster before the game starts. Alert your coach if anyone is missing so they can be added in time.

Start & end the game

Tap **Start Game**, select the play type, assign the player, and confirm. Tap **End Game** when the game is complete, then review the summary and proceed to make corrections if needed.

Add notes to any play

You can add a note directly to any play during the game. If you made an error, add a note right away to flag it for correction.

Correct errors your way

Fix mistakes **while tracking live**, or add a note and make corrections **after End Game** — either way works.

GET QUICK ACCESS

Add Blitz Board Stats to your phone or tablet's home screen so you can open it like an app on game day — no app store needed.

iPhone & iPad (Safari)

- 1 Open **blitzboardstats.com** in Safari.
- 2 Tap **Share** (square with an arrow) — bottom on iPhone, top toolbar on iPad.
- 3 Scroll down and tap **Add to Home Screen**.
- 4 Tap **Add** in the top-right corner.

Android Phone & Tablet (Chrome)

- 1 Open **blitzboardstats.com** in Chrome.
- 2 Tap the **three-dot menu** (top-right; near the address bar on tablets).
- 3 Tap **Add to Home screen** (or **Install app**).
- 4 Tap **Add / Install** to confirm.

Once added, the Blitz Board Stats icon opens straight into the site — no need to type the web address on game day.

Special teams quick reference

The two most common questions we get: punting and receiving

SWITCHING MODES

On the tracking screen, use the **Punting / Receiving** toggle to match what your team is doing on the play, and keep the **Special teams** box checked. This changes which result buttons show up next.

PUNTING (YOUR TEAM IS KICKING)

Punting flow

- 1 Toggle to **Punting** and confirm the field position / yard line.
- 2 Tap **Choose** under Manage Roster to select the punter.
- 3 Tap the punting result: **Down**, **Return**, **Touchback**, **Out of Bounds**, or **Fumbled/Muffed Punt**.
- 4 If it's a **Return**, enter the return yard line, then pick the result: **Flag Pull**, **Return Touchdown**, **Player Out of Bounds**, **Player Down**, **Safety**, or **Lateral Pass**.

RECEIVING (YOUR TEAM IS RETURNING)

Receiving flow

- 1 Toggle to **Receiving** and confirm the field position / yard line.
- 2 Enter **Punt Received At** — the yard line where your player fielded the punt — and tap **Confirm & Track Play**.
- 3 Pick the return result: **Flag Pull**, **Return Touchdown**, **Player Out of Bounds**, **Player Down**, or **Safety**.
- 4 If the ball changed hands mid-return, use **Lateral Pass** instead of a return result.

QUICK TIPS

Muffed or fumbled punts

Use **Fumbled/Muffed Punt** (punting side) if the receiving team never controls the ball cleanly — don't log a return result for it.

Not sure which mode?

If your team is kicking, use **Punting**. If your team is catching or returning, use **Receiving**. The toggle only affects this one play.
